CARPINTERIA SANITARY DISTRICT BEGINS FINAL DESIGN FOR SOUTH COAST BEACH  
COMMUNITIES SEPTIC TO SEWER PROJECT  
Final Design Engineering Underway

August 6, 2009

Following several years of preliminary design, public hearings and environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the Carpinteria Sanitary District has begun final design on the South Coast Beach Communities Septic to Sewer project for the Rincon Point, Sand Point, and Sandyland Cove communities.

The project includes extending District infrastructure to serve over 130 properties with a low pressure sewer system. Once in place, the existing septic systems will be abandoned.

Project costs are being shared by the property owners and a Prop 84 Clean Beaches Program Grant from the State Water Resources Control Board.

Final engineering and permitting are expected to extend into 2010, with construction commencing shortly thereafter. Penfield & Smith has worked closely with the District on the project design since the 1990's and has been contracted to complete the final design.
